constrain and shape decisions in electricity distribution contrary to conventional wisdom it concludes that attempts to depoliticize the sector are misplaced and could worsen outcomes instead it suggests that a historically grounded political economy analysis helps understand the past and devise reforms to simultaneously improve sectoral outcomes and generate political rewards these arguments have implications for the challenges facing india s electricity future including providing electricity to all implementing government reform schemes and successfully managing the rise of renewable
